# **TOP VIEW** OF UNIT BACK OF UNIT **Buttons:** A- Alarm Set B- Hour C- Minute UNDERSIDE OF UNIT D- Time Set E- Tuner F- Fortune G- Snooze/Sleep/Time Announce H- Head Light I- Volume Wheel

For Mp3 insert one end of the Mp3 Jack Wire (P) into the headphone slot on your Mp3 player. Insert the other end of the Mp3 Jack Wire (P) into AUX slot (N) located on the back. Press the RADIO ON (K) button until "AUX" appears on the LCD screen. Operate your Mp3 normally, use the VOLUME wheel (E) to adjust volume level. NOTE: Keep your Mp3 player's volume below maximum level to avoid static and distortion.

# Sleep Mode:

J- Off

M- Power Input

O- Power Adapter

P- MP3 Input Jack Wire

N- AUX Input

K- Radio On AM/FM/AUX

L- Alarm On Hi/Low/AM/FM

Only works while playing Radio/Mp3. Press SNOOZE (G) button to set the sleep time, 15, 30, 45 and 60 minute segments. The LCD will display the desired length of time on the right hand side of the LCD screen. MRCR will count down the minutes while playing the radio or Mp3 player. MRCR will automatically shut off when length of time is up.

### Alarm Mode:

Press the ALARM ON Hi/Lo/AM/FM (L) button to enter into Alarm Mode and ALARM Icon is displayed at the bottom of the LCD screen.

Press the ALARM ON (L) button again to scroll to your desired alarm mode. Modes are Hi/Low/AM/FM

- Display HI intense alarm (15 random alarm shows)
- Display LO gentle alarm (15 random alarm shows)
- Display Radio AM radio alarm with AM band.
- Display Radio FM radio alarm with FM band.

For radio alarm mode to work properly, you must set your desired radio station and volume level.

On activation alarm will sound for 60 minutes and then enter a normal Clock Mode, if no action is taken,

Press SNOOZE (G) button to shut alarm off for 5 minutes, alarm will resume after 5 minutes

Press OFF (J) button to shut off alarm immediately.

# Clock Time Setting:

Press and Hold TIMESET (D) button and press HOUR (B) button or MINUTE (C) button to adjust time.

# Alarm Clock Time Setting:

Press and hold ALARMSET (A) button and press HOUR (B) button or MINUTE (C) to adjust desired wake-up time.

# **Button Functions:**

Alarm Set	Sets the alarm time
Hour	Sets the hour/Period of time reporting
Minute	Sets the minute/Interval of time reporting
Time Set	Sets time of day
Fortune	Gives the answers to your Questions
Snooze	Sleep late/Sleep/Time Announce
Reporting/Respond/Demo	
Head Light	Turns Head Lights on as a night light
Off	Cancels all functions and reverts to Time Mod
Radio On (AM/FM/AUX)	Radio Mode/Select wave band
Alarm On (Hi/Lo/AM/FM)	Alarm Mode/Select alarm output

Please note that MRCR (Mr. Clock Radio) powers on automatically when Power Adapter (O) is plugged-into Power Input (M).

#### **DEMO Mode:**

The DEMO (Z) switch is located on the underside (bottom) of MRCR. If the DEMO (Z) switch is in the ON position, pressing SNOOZE (G) button will cause MRCR to perform a short demonstration. All other functions are disabled if DEMO is on.

The following functions will not work until you slide the "DEMO" (Z) switch to the OFF position.

Five Modes: Awake Mode/Radio Mode/Alarm mode/Sleep Mode/ Clock Mode

#### Awake Mode:

A motion sensor indicates when someone is in the room and MRCR wakes up. MRCR will remain active for 5 minutes. If after 5 minutes there is no motion detected MRCR will go to sleep.

Note: As long as MRCR is awake he will randomly say things.

#### Radio Mode:


For Radio press RADIO ON (K) to enter MRCR to Radio Mode. Set the mode AM/FM/AUX by pressing RADIO ON (K) button until desired mode shows on the bottom of the LCD screen. In AM or FM mode rotate TUNER wheel (E) to desired radio station. Rotate VOLUME wheel (I) to adjust volume level.

# Time Announcing Mode:

This mode makes MRCR act like a Cuckoo Clock. Press MINUTE (C) button to change the pie shaped icon in the upper right hand corner of the LCD screen.

- Announces time on the hour.
- Announces time on the half hour.
- Announces the time on the quarter hour.

Press HOUR (B) button to choose the time period for announcing.



MRCR will announce the time all 24 hours.

# Real Time Announcing:

This function works in Clock Mode and Alarm Mode. (does not work while

Press SNOOZE (G) button and MRCR will announce the current time.

This function works in Clock Mode, Radio Mode, and Alarm Mode. Press the FORTUNE (F) button and MRCR will prompt you to ask a Yes or No question. Press the SNOOZE (G) button after asking a question and MRCR will give you an answer. Note; you only have 30 seconds in which to ask your question and press the SNOOZE button, you will see a countdown on the LCD

# Night Light:

This function works in Clock Mode, Radio Mode and Alarm Mode. Press NIGHTLIGHT (H) button to change the display of the two LED lights on the MRCR head. Press once and the lights stay on steadily, functioning as a light night. Press again and the LED lights will flash. Press a third time to shut lights off.

Battery Back-up:

Insert two "AAA" batteries in the battery compartment located on the bottom of MRCR. You will need to use a Philips head screwdriver to remove the door screw. If ever there is a power outage/surge MRCR will not lose its time
