

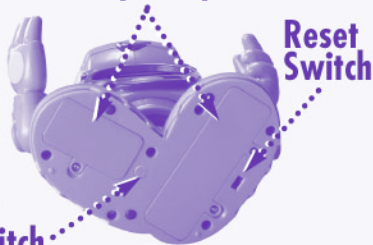

Getting Started

1. Install three “D” **alkaline** batteries in both battery compartments located on the underside of Kasey’s feet.
2. Be sure the Reset Switch (located on the underside of Kasey’s foot) is in the “on” position.
3. Press the Power Button on Kasey’s foot to bring him to life.
4. Adjust the Volume Dial to a comfortable listening level; adjust the Contrast Dial to make the image on the display screen darker or lighter.
5. Press a Colored Selection Button to go to an activity. Use the Colored Selection Buttons to answer questions too.

Tips and Hints

1. Use **only** the Colored Selection Buttons to make menu selections or answer questions.
2. Kasey should be positioned at or near your child’s eye level and on a level surface.
3. Press the Home Button to return to the previous menu; continue to press the Home Button to return to the main menu.
4. If Kasey seems to be stuck in a particular action, slide the Reset Switch on the underside of Kasey’s foot off and then back on.
5. Replace **all three batteries** with three, fresh “D” **alkaline** batteries when: the display on screen is difficult to see (after adjusting the Contrast Dial); sounds become faint or there are no sounds at all (and Volume Dial is turned all the way up); movement slows or stops; or the toy functions erratically.
6. This toy features an automatic shut-off, and will turn off if your child is not actively playing with it after about one minute. You can also turn power off by pressing the Power Button on Kasey’s foot.

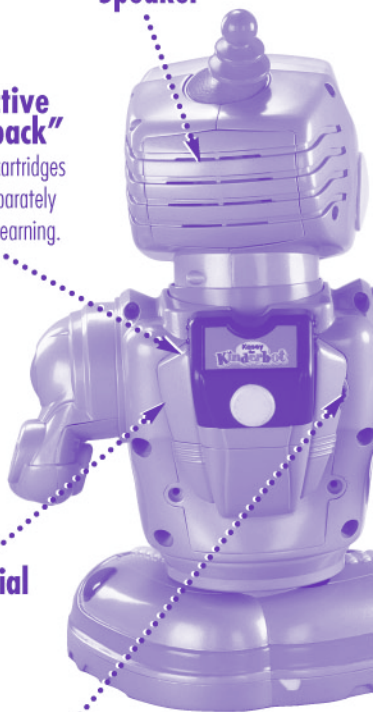

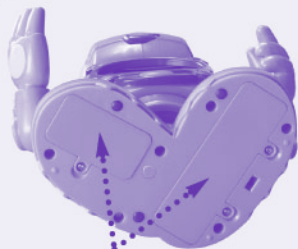

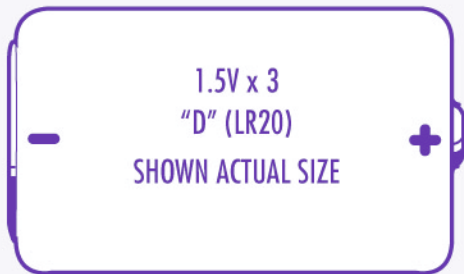
2 Battery Compartments

Installation

- An adult must install batteries. Tool needed for battery installation: Phillips screwdriver (not included). Requires three “D” (LR20) **alkaline** batteries for operation (batteries not included).
- Locate both battery compartments on the underside of Kasey’s feet.
- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment doors with a Phillips screwdriver. Lift to remove the battery compartment doors.
- Insert three “D” (LR20) **alkaline** batteries as indicated inside both battery compartments in Kasey’s feet.
- Replace the battery compartment doors and tighten the screws in each door with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

Hints:

- We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.
- You can expect approximately 12 hours of power with each fresh set of batteries.



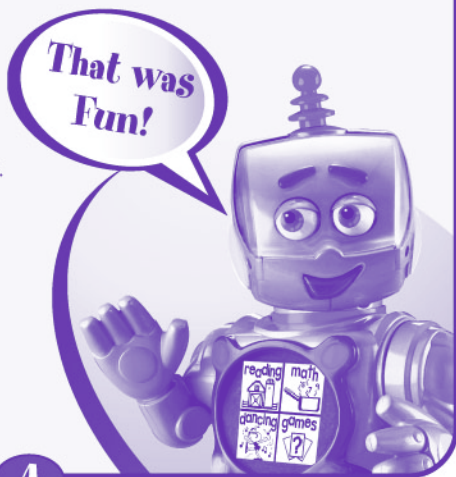
Battery Safety Information

Batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your toy. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the toy. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. The batteries may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- If removeable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Care

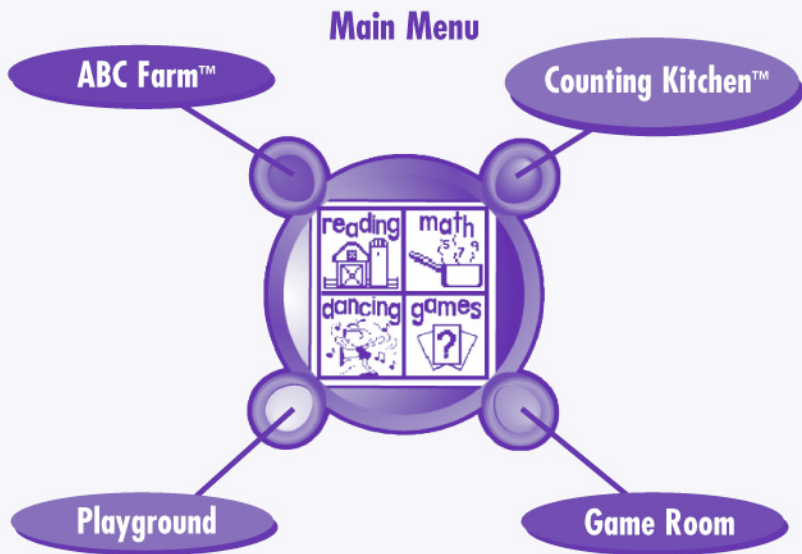
- Kasey is not intended for use outdoors.
- Wipe this toy with a clean cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Do not immerse this toy.
- This toy has no consumer serviceable parts. Please do not take this toy apart.
- Do not drop this toy on a hard surface.
- Keep this toy away from direct sunlight and excessive heat.
- Keep water, sand and dirt off this toy.

Troubleshooting Guide

Symptom

Solution

I've made a selection, but Kasey does not recognize it.

- Do not touch the screen to make selections. Always press the Colored Selection Button next to the screen.

I've pressed a Colored Selection Button, but Kasey does not recognize it.

- Do not make a selection until the Colored Selection Buttons light.
- Battery power may be weak. Replace **all** batteries with fresh, **alkaline** batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries.

You hear a snapping or grinding noise and one of Kasey's parts does not move.

- The moving parts are jammed because there may be an object lodged between them. Turn power off and remove the object.

Kasey stops moving when I pick him up or tilt him; but he still talks and his screen still functions.

- There is a Tilt Button on the underside of Kasey's foot. When you pick him up or tilt him, he will stop moving. When you place him back down, he begins moving again.

Kasey appears to be stuck in a particular action.

- You need to reset the electronics. Slide the Reset Switch on the underside of Kasey's foot to the off position and then back on.

After installing fresh batteries, Kasey seems to run for only one or two hours.

- You may have installed the wrong type of batteries. Use only **alkaline** batteries for longest battery life.

Kasey moves sluggishly.

- The batteries are dead or weak. Replace **all** batteries with fresh, **alkaline** batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries.

Screen images are faint.

- Adjust contrast by rotating the Contrast Dial.
- The batteries are dead or weak. Replace **all** batteries with fresh, **alkaline** batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries.

Kasey's voice is faint or he doesn't speak at all.

- Adjust volume by rotating the Volume Dial.
- The batteries are dead or weak. Replace **all** batteries with fresh, **alkaline** batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries.

Kasey functions erratically and Power Button does not work when pushed.

- Battery power is weak and you will need to reset the electronics. Slide the Reset Switch on the underside of Kasey's foot to the off position. Replace **all** three batteries with fresh, **alkaline** batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries. Slide the Reset Switch to the on position.
